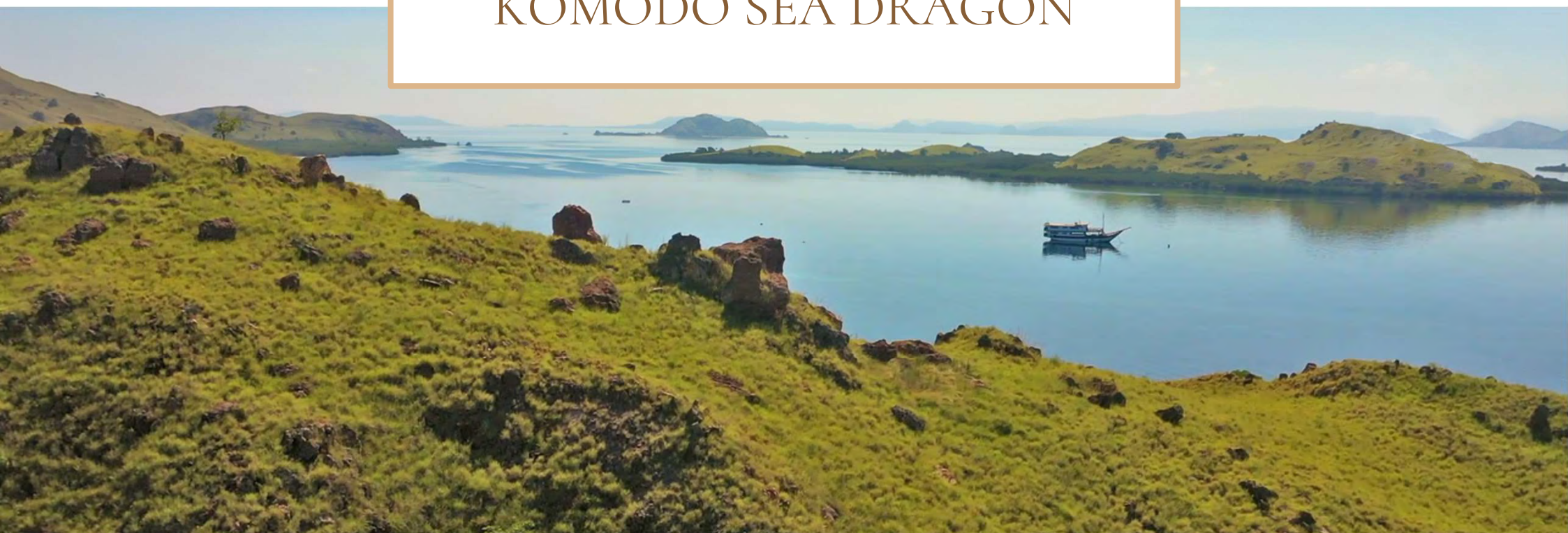

The Komodo Sea Dragon and her support Boat Putra Sebayur (18 x 4 metres) are designed for divers and snorkellers alike. Each trip is tailor-made to cater to our guests' preferences as well as accounting for the weather conditions, tides, currents and any other prevailing events. Putra Sebayur is equipped with compressors, dive tanks and rescue / safety kits,

The large upper deck of the Komodo Sea Dragon is equipped with eight sun loungers and the main deck features a relax area convertible into an outdoor dining space, so you can enjoy a refreshing breeze along breath-taking views and a cocktail from our outdoor bar.

The air-conditioned lounge and dining area are also located on the main deck. Next to it you can find our small library and audio/video entertainment providing plenty of space and the possibility to cool down.

The kitchen and crew quarters are located on the lower deck.

# OUR LOCATION



About an hour boat ride away from Labuan Bajo, on the eastern part of Sebayur Besar Island and exactly next to the border of Komodo National Park, lies the Komodo Resort and Diving Club.

This strategic location allows us easy and fast access to the Komodo National Park and also provides a private, safe and serene sanctuary for all of our guests.

Direct domestic flights to Komodo Airport in Labuan Bajo are available from Jakarta, Bali, Surabaya, and Kupang.

# TRANSFER

Our trip will start and end at Komodo Resort on Sebayur Island:

- We provide a free two-way car transfer from Labuan Bajo harbour to the airport or hotels in downtown Labuan Bajo, on the first and last day of the cruise.
- A complimentary return boat shuttle from Labuan Bajo harbour to Sebayur Island is available at 12pm on the first and last day of the cruise.

For guests arriving and departing on the same day of the departure and return of the cruise, we recommend to book flights arriving in Labuan Bajo no later than 11 am and departing after 2 pm local time.

Outside the scheduled shuttle boat times, private boat transfer can be arranged at a surcharge.
